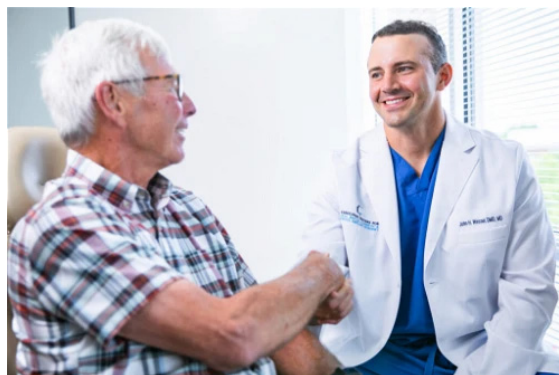

While at Harvard, he published on the topic of Bisphosphonate-Related Osteonecrosis of the Jaws. His research would later be used to help develop the standard of care for treating this disease.

After dental school, Dr. Wessel completed his residency training at the Rutgers Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery Program in Newark, NJ. During this time he also obtained his Medical Doctorate from the New Jersey Medical School and completed a one year internship in general surgery. During residency training Dr. Wessel enjoyed participating in the education of dental students, lecturing on various topics such as patient management, obstructive sleep apnea, and numerous medical diseases. Dr. Wessel has traveled multiple times to perform cleft lip and palate repair to the indigenous people of Bangladesh, with the non-profit group Smile Bangladesh.
