Dr. I.E. Davis, III is a native of Lake City, SC. He attended Furman University on an athletic scholarship (football). Dr. Davis graduated from Furman in 1980 with a biology degree. He then attended dental school at The Medical University of South Carolina. Dr. Davis finished dental school in 1985. He then pursued further training at the University Of Mississippi School Of Dentistry as a general practice resident finishing in 1986. Upon completion of his general dentistry residency, Dr. Davis practiced general dentistry from 1986–1989 in Woodruff, SC.

After three years of general dentistry practice, he decided to specialize in oral surgery and was accepted for training at the University of Minnesota. He completed his oral and maxillofacial surgery training at the University of Minnesota Hospital and Clinics in 1993.
